

## **Call for Short-Term Scientific Missions**

The COST Action "Evaluation of Ocean Syntheses" (EOS) aims to improve the understanding of the value and use of ocean syntheses by supporting individual mobility, strengthening existing networks and fostering collaboration between researchers. The EOS network consists of experts in physical oceanography, hydrodynamic modelling, climate research, data assimilation, Earth observation, ocean synthesis and reanalysis, and air-sea flux measurements, among others.

EOS provides funding opportunities for short research stays that can contribute to the main goals of the Action.

A Short Term Scientific Mission (STSM) is a research stay, aligned with the goals of the Action that is providing the funding, extending for a period from 1 week to 3 months (junior members could benefit from longer stays). According to COST rules, the Action partially funds those stays with an amount of up to  $\leq 2,500$  (up to  $\leq 3,500$  in the case of junior members and longer stays).

Opportunities exist for STSMs between any institutes within the COST countries (institutes do not need to be prior members of EOS). We are still seeking STSM proposals to take place within the current year 2015, as well as for future years.
